MARINE CORPS LEAGUE
SCHOLARSHIP PURPOSE, ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS FOR 2022-2023

PURPOSE:

To grant Scholarships to qualified applicants who are pursuing **full time undergraduate (twelve hours or more) or technical training at a full-time recognized institution.** Three scholarships of \$500.00 will be awarded only. These will be awarded for one year only. Only one scholarship per family will be awarded. Any senior residing in Oceana or Mason County or any senior attending school in Oceana or Mason County that is directly related to a Marine is eligible. The Scholarship will only be awarded to high school seniors attending college in the fall. If you already attend college, you are not eligible.

ELIGIBILITY:

- (1) Any Senior residing in Oceana or Mason County (including Montague) or any senior attending a school in Oceana or Mason County (including Montague) that has a relative that served in the Marine Corps- Grand Father, Grand Mother, Father, Mother, Sister, Brother, Aunt, Uncle, Cousin.....
- (2) Children of Marines who have lost their lives in the line of duty.
- (3) Any Detachment members Child or Grandchild living outside this area.

ALL APPLICANTS MUST SATISFY THE BELOWLIST REQUIREMENTS:

- (1) All applicants must write an essay on “Patriotism and being an American”
- (2) Complete and sign the application and ensure the application is totally completed.
- (3) The required signatures. The application will not be processed without this compliance.
- (4) **The application must be postmarked by April 30, 2023.**

ADMINISTRATION OF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

- (1) If you are selected, you will be required to show proof of enrollment for 2023-2024.
- (2) Incomplete applications will not be considered, nor will they be returned for completion.
- (3) Letters of recommendation *are not required*, nor will they be considered.
- (4) Eligibility and compliance will be strictly observed by the Scholarship Committee.
- (5) Decisions by the Scholarship Committee are final.
- (6) Applicants will be notified of Award by the Committee Chairman prior to graduation 2023.
