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### **Review of Second Reading - NEOLA Policy Update: Volume 32, Number 1; Technology Special Policy Updates**

We will review the second reading of the NEOLA Policy updates for Volume 32, Number 1, which was recently released. The policy brief that can be shared at the board meeting for the second reading of the policies is attached. I would like to propose that we adopt the policies as they are presented, with the exception of the policies that are not required by law until the 2018 - 2019 school year. I would propose that we adopt the policies adding a statement that makes it clear that the implementation of the policy will take effect on July 1, 2018, when required to do so by law. This will provide the appropriate timeliness to communicate the policy with all staff and ensure that the community understands that this is in response to requirements of the law. The policy updates include:
