Dear Parents, Guardians, and Families:

In accordance with the District's COVID-19 Return to Learn Safety Mitigation Plan, the District has reviewed the most recent data available from the Centers for Disease Control. The data for Mason County indicates a COVID-19 positivity rate of 17.09% for the date range of Friday, October 22, 2021, through Thursday, October 28, 2021. The District plan identifies the requirement for staff, students, and visitors to wear a mask that covers both the nose and mouth when the Mason County positivity rate reaches 10.0%. In response to this updated CDC information, the District will be requiring masks for this week of school, beginning on November 1, 2021.
