ATTENDANCE

Please download the app ClassDojo for your cell phone. This will be our main form of communication. I will be sending an invite letter for you, so that it will automatically connect with our classroom on there. I am also available by calling the school & email if necessary. I do not look at my messages before or after school, so if you send something, I will respond during the school day when I am able to do so.

CLASS WORK

I know that home life can be crazy and have lots of scheduling conflicts, so I do not assign homework. All our work will be given an appropriate amount of time to finish here at school.

I do participate in the Pizza Book-It program and give out O-Bucks to students who read at home and keep track of it on a log every month.

I also send home spelling lists, so if you would like to work with those at home, that would be beneficial.

If you have any concerns or would like to have work sent home, I can set something up with you on a one-on-one basis, but this would be specifically for practice, not for grading.

MISC.

Snack is on your own. Please bring one from home. You are always welcome to send snacks in for us to share.

We participate in a 30-minute chunk of what I call "Fun Friday." When students have all work complete and have not had any serious behavior issues all week, they are able to participate. If they do not complete the classwork, I will have them work on the missing work.
