Dear 2B Remote Learning Families:

I hope this message finds you and your family well. The past few weeks we have been working through the process to hire a 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade 2B remote learning full-time instructor for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. Please join me in welcoming Ms. Maggie Nagle to the Foster Elementary staff as our new remote learning instructor!

As educators, we are always looking to improve instruction for all students. After the first trimester, we learned that our 2B remote students need the attention of a full-time teacher in addition to the technology support of Ms. Moeggenberg. Ms. Nagle will begin taking over lead teaching duties for Ms. Moeggenberg throughout January 2021 as Ms Moeggenberg will be transitioning back to her technology support role within the district. Google Meet times will not change during the transition. Be sure to utilize the link in Canvas to access your grade level's Google Meet. The planned timeline to transition Ms. Moeggenberg out of the teaching role and Ms. Nagle into the teaching role is as follows:

- Week of January 4th Ms. Nagle takes over 3rd grade instruction. (*Ms. Moggenberg keeps 4th & 5th grades.*)
- Week of January 18th Ms. Nagle takes over 4th grade instruction in addition to 3rd grade. (Ms. Moeggenberg keeps 5th grade.)
- Week of February 1st Ms. Nagle takes over 5th grade instruction in addition to 3rd and 4th grades. *(Ms. Moeggenberg transitions out.)*

For those students with special education supports, Mrs. Cooper will continue to provide your special education accommodations as your teacher. We are very excited to add Ms. Nagle to our team. Her experience teaching remotely, using the various technology resources we have available within the district, and her familiarity of the Ludington community and its families will benefit our students. Enjoy your last week of the holiday break. We are excited to continue remote instruction on January 4th, 2021!
