 - Kids will get 10-15 minutes to run around the gym with glow sticks, afterwards they will get donut holes and apple cider (to be donated)
 - Signupgenius for teachers, Katie will work with Ashely to set up times
 - Will also need parent volunteers and snack donations
 - In past years the prizes were:

- Popcorn party- wesco donated popcorn, PTC bought cups
- Ice cream party
- Silly String PTC purchased
- Stix bowling party donated from Stix
- Reward tiers this year amount by grade
 - Each student receives a glow stick for participation
 - \$4000 popcorn in classroom
