i. President Update:

a. 2 mini grant proposals-

- i. Lisa O'connor, was buying prizes out of her own pocket. Has asked for \$30 for prizes. Rewarding the students with an 'o' buck was also proposed. This would also tie into the PBIS program. We are going to vote on approving her grant, then encourage her to use the o bucks after that.
- ii. Peggy smith, \$50 for prizes for behavior modification for the kids.
- iii. Fun walk prizes are available for some of this too. We don't have enough left over to use for the next fun walk in the Spring. Some can also go towards the Little O store.
- iv. Leftover fun walk prizes will go to the little o store, and grants can go to library and Ms. Peggy.
- v. Motion to approve: Carol Hubbard, 2nd: Jen Vogel. All in favor... motion passed

ii. Fundraisers:

- a. Another option for a fun walk was brought up by Heidi Urka, where kids get pledges for acts of kindness. This year has been focused on kindness within Franklin so it would tie in. Heidi will look into if the school she had heard this from, makes enough \$ to replace the fun walk. And will also look into how they monitor it.
- b. We are going to put that idea on the back burner till next year since the fun walk has already been planted with the students.
 - i. We do need to up the ante for this, help with goals to be hit etc. Barbie proposed prizes like we had at Foster (\$200 was swimming with Mr. Dotson at West Shore etc.) Mrs. Eisinger said she would be open to a pizza party, lunches with her, movie experience etc.
 - ii. We want to make less prize levels, and make them more meaningful. Start at \$25.00. Something that the children will get excited about.
 - iii. If we hit a school wide goal, we can add in another Franklin fun day.
 - iv. April 12th for fun walk. We will collect money till May 3rd.

- iii. Reading Month: We have a line item in the budget for this, just need to amend budget to include \$150. Motion to approve: Barbie Eaton, 2nd: Charlotte Nickelson. All in favor... motion passed.
 - a. 1 of 2 avenues,
 - i. 1. One book, one school: One book per classroom to be funded by PTC. About \$120.
 - ii. 2. Franklin created, more focused on picture books.
 - iii. Assemblies - aerocona, a possibility. They are a company who do most of them in the spring. Donation based.
- iv. Treasurer Update:
 - a. Budget available and checking account available upon request.
 - b. We got a check from box tops, we need to write a check for PMECC.
- v. Box Tops:
 - a. Must be post marked by March 1st.
 - b. Students turn into teachers by Feb 15th. Teachers turn into Erin by Feb 18th.
- vi. Staff appreciation: Feb 28th 2019. Principal and teachers thank the PTC for the previous luncheon.
- vii. Book fair: Arrives 18th/19th feb, Set up is feb 22nd after school, opening mornings 7:45-8:30am, and an hour after school each day. Mondays hours will be 3pm-3:45pm. Tuesday 7:45-8:30am; 3pm-3:45pm. Wednesday will be 3pm-3:45pm; 5pm-7:30pm, Thursday will be 7:45am-8:30am; 1-3:30pm; 5pm-7:30pm. Friday will be 7:45-8:30am; 11:30am-12:15pm.
