SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- 1. Application will be accepted January 1st through April 1st. NO applications will be accepted after April 1st.
- 2. Sponsor must be a Parent/Grandparent of applicant AND be a current member of Post #76 (Legion, S.A.L. or Auxiliary).
- 3. Amount of scholarship will be \$1,000.00.
- 4. Applications will be screened and approved by the Scholarship Committee.
- 5. Scholarships will be awarded on a one (1) time only basis.
- 6. A limit of 7 scholarships may be given out each year unless otherwise approved by the Scholarship Committee and Executive Board. Preference will be given to high school seniors but graduated students will be considered.
- 7. Scholarship checks will be a two (2) party check made out to the scholarship recipient and the college/school they plan to attend.
